Paddling Fees

With effect from 1 July a ‘one-off’ paddling fee of £15 will be paid with the annual subscription. This will eliminate the need to collect funds from you each paddling night leaving only kit hire payable.

With immediate effect kit hire is £5 per night irrespective of the number of items hired. Hire fees for a week are £30 with a deposit of £20. For off site kit hire there is a liability cover of 50% for any necessary replacement/repair.
